
SINK INSTALLATION

- 1. Cut hole 1/2" to 5/8" smaller than overall length and width of sink.
- 2. Center sink in hole on countertop.
- 3. Slip L-bracket over studs and lightly tighten wing nut.
- 4. Make sure L-bracket makes contact with the sink and not the stud plate (see "A" on illustration below).
- 5. Working in a clockwise manner, firmly tighten all wing nuts. **NOTE: Do not overtighten wing nuts, as this can cause the stud to break loose from the sink.**
- 6. 100% Silicone caulk is recommended for sealing kitchen and utility sinks to the counter top.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

To repair light scratches to the sink, please follow the instructions below.

NOTE: IF SCRATCHES ARE LESS THAN 1/64" DEEP, SKIP TO STEP 2. FOR MINOR BLEMISHES, SKIP TO STEP 3.

- 1. Wet sand damaged surface, starting with 600 grit sandpaper, in a circular motion. Change to 1000-grit sandpaper and repeat.
- 2. Wet sand damaged surface starting with 1200 and 1500 grit sandpaper in a circular motion.
- 3. Buff the damaged surface with a clean cloth and some plastic polish until scratches are gone. GS27 Classics[®] Titanium[®] Scratch Remover or Novus[®] NO. 2 Plastic Polish is recommended.
- 4. Repeat if necessary.



WARNING: Dry cleaning agents and solvents will damage sink. For routine cleaning please use standard dish soap and water.

Do not allow burning cigarettes to touch sink surface.
